Overview of GCSE Results

We are very proud of our students, and the results this Summer reflect both the hard work and dedication of our students and teachers alike. Our predictions for our current Year 11 students are looking even stronger. We had some notable successes this summer, with many students exceeding their aspirational target grades. Yash Rajput achieved an outstanding 10A*s, including a 9 in maths; Lucy Lord and Thomas Wills achieved 9A*s (with Lucy gaining a 9 in maths and English literature and Thomas a 9 in English language and literature); Isobel Thomson and Abigail McLoughlin-Dymond both achieved 7A*s (Isobel got a 9 in English language and literature and Abigail a 9 in maths). A further 3 students achieved 9s in English language and literature and ten students achieved at least 7 As - A*s.

Overview of A Level Results

This was a fantastic year for our Sixth Form results and we are immensely proud of the progress our students achieved. We had a number of students who achieved some very special results, such as Rhianne Good who achieved three A grades in Textiles, History and English Literature; an A* for her EPQ and an A in her Sociology AS; Rose Nicholson achieved three A grades in Mathematics, Physics and Geography and an A* for her EPQ and Sophie Clarke who achieved an A* in Photography A*, an A in Business Studies and a B in Sociology.

Although attainment is very important, even more so is progress. Our Sixth Form was judged to be in the top 25% nationally for the progress our students made. A wide range of our subjects produced results that were likewise in that national top 25%. These included: Photography; Business Studies; English Language; Film Studies; History; Physics and Psychology.
