




Building their vocabulary gives your child:

### Guidance for students:

- $\checkmark$  In addition to your homework you should learn these words during each term
- Towards the end of each term (your teacher will tell you when) you may be tested on your ability to spell these words and your ability to use them correctly within sentences
- $\checkmark$  You will certainly need to know these words for end of unit assessments/tests
- ✓ We'd encourage you to LOOK (at the word), COVER (the word with your hand), WRITE (the word) and CHECK (that you've spelt it correctly)
- ✓ Alternatively, you could adopt the PRACTISE > PRACTISE > PRACTISE > PERFECT! method
- ✓ Displaying words on illustrated mind-maps or using flashcards to help you revise will help
- $\checkmark$  Finally, try to use new words within your spoken language this will help you to embed them



Guidance for parents/carers:

- Discussion is key: try to share in the learning of new vocabulary
- Ideally, students should be provided with a quiet space in which to work
- $\checkmark$  Provision of a vocabulary notebook would be great
- If you want to test your child, read each word aloud and then put it in a sentence for them to provide context (they then write the word)
