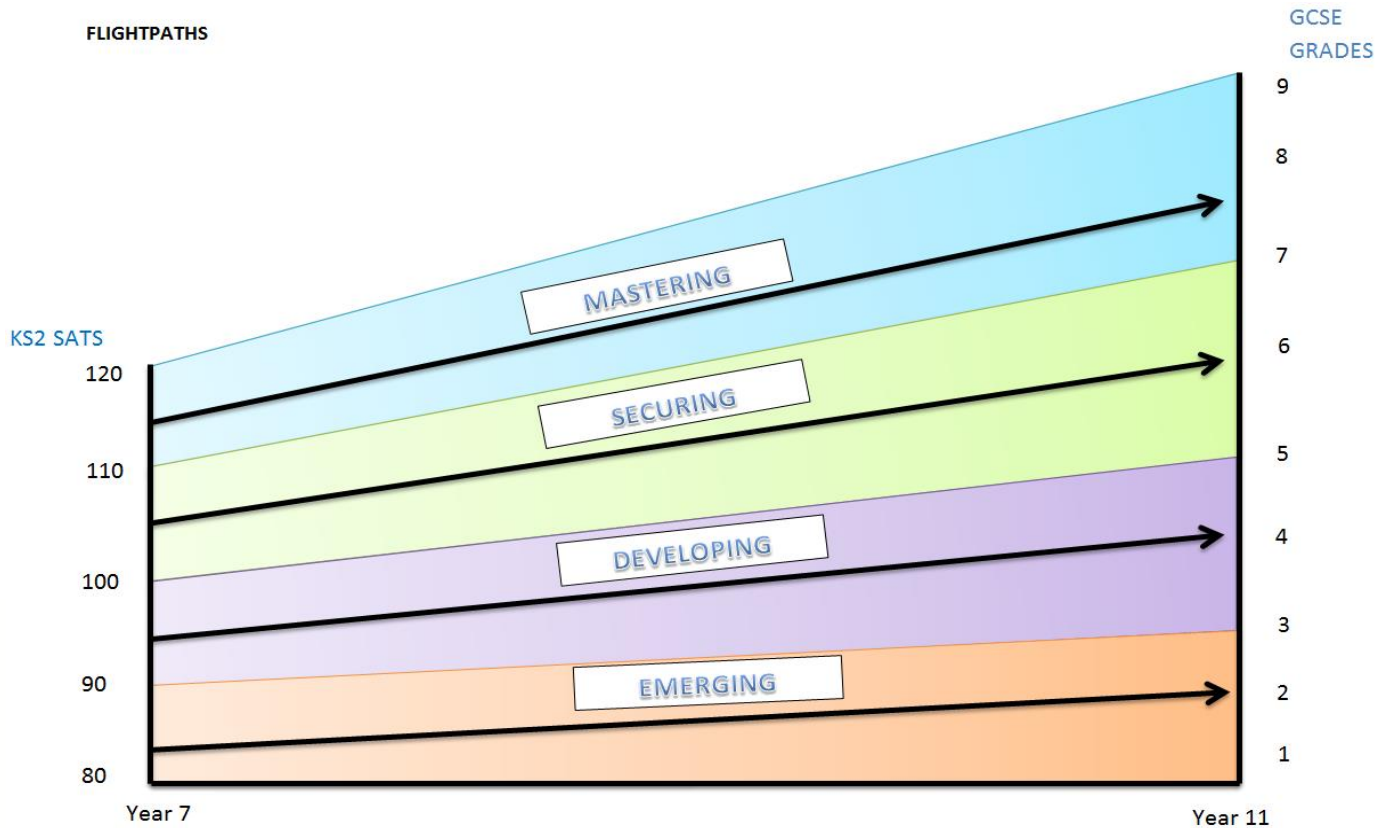
What we receive from primary school:

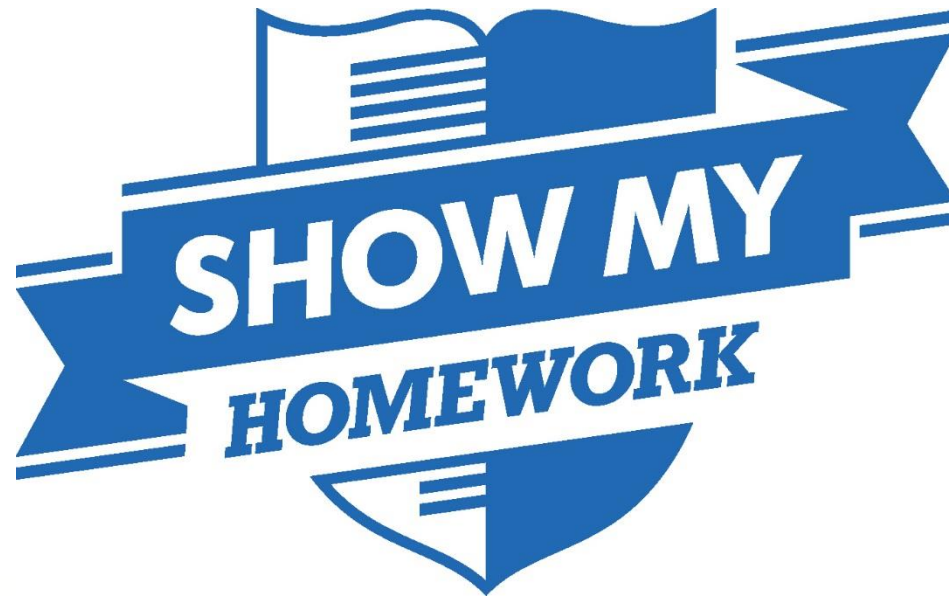

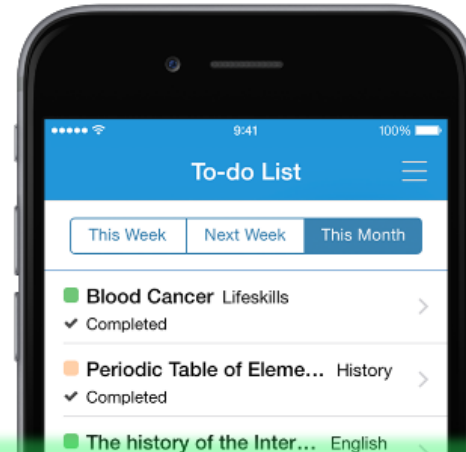

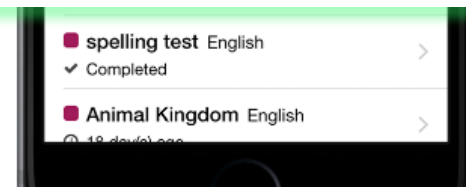

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Detention System

C1

1. Warning given.
2. Student is moved seats.
3. **Detention takes place at break or lunch time that day and with subject teacher.**
4. Consequence is logged on SIMS (parents notified via email)

C2

1. Student is 'parked' in an alternative class.
2. Subject teacher logs consequence on SIMS and phones home the same day.
3. **Middle Leaders detention takes place the following day until 3.30pm in detention room.**
4. **All P.5 teachers take students with a Middle Leaders detention take students to the detention room at the end of the lesson.**

C3

1. Any student internally excluded will have an extended school day until 3.50pm in BASE.

The consequence and punctuality systems are clear and any poor behaviour will be followed with an immediate sanction.

These systems are in place to ensure that poor behaviour for learning does not have a negative impact on students learning.

Rewards

‘Points mean Prizes..’

- All House Points awarded will be recorded on SIMS.
- Once a week (silent reading), tutors will add the previous weeks HP stamps to tutees stamp cards.
- Each house will have a specific day within which students can ‘spend’ their house points in the shop (LRC).
 - Run by Year 11 prefects.
- A variety of items will be available in the shop and students can choose whether to cash in their points on a weekly basis or save them for a larger reward.

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MFL at Oldfield

What languages will my child learn at Key Stage 3?

- * Year 7: 6 lessons of either French or Spanish over 2 weeks
- * Year 8: 2 dual linguist groups given the chance to learn the other language based on Y7 data & teacher feedback. All other students will continue to learn the language they started in Y7.
- * Year 9: As Year 8 with reviews of groups based on Y8 data & teacher feedback
- * GCSE: Choice to carry on language(s) learnt in Y7-9
- * A level: Opt if studied at GCSE and achieved Grade 6+



How can I help my child progress in languages?

- * 4 skills – Listening, speaking, reading writing
- * Let them teach YOU – ‘teach me 3 new words’
- * Test them on vocabulary for tests or just keep helping them go over recently learnt words
- * Encourage them to use FREE well-designed learning websites **Quizlet, Memrise, Fluencia, language-gym, Duolingo**
- * Suggest they follow the monthly French or Spanish music charts
- * Borrow or watch their own films and put on the French/Spanish subtitles (Disney for instance)
- * Look out for groups like Kevin Karla y la Banda on Youtube – they translate popular English songs into Spanish or Sara’h (French songs with lyric videos)
- * Use ‘Lyricstraining’ website to listen to songs like ‘Let it go’ and they have to fill the gaps

- * Students may decide to wear underlayers / skins

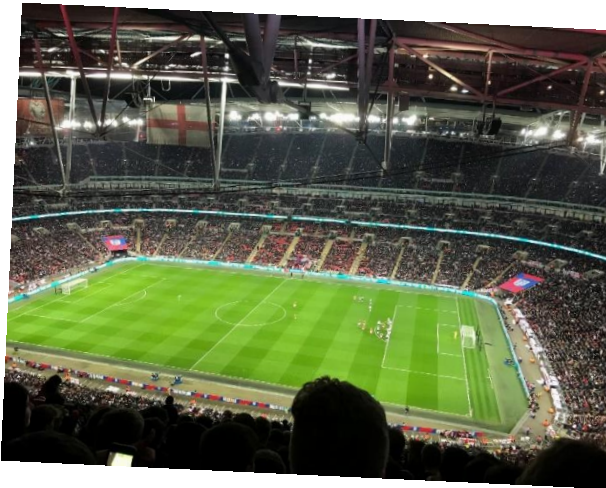
