### Challenge Four – Lets get a little quizzy!

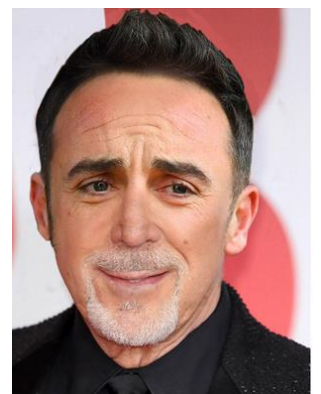
Lots of people are using social media to host quizzes with their friends or family or hosting quizzes at home with their family.
