# (②) Summarise:

### What have you just read?

- Identify the subject/topic (often found in a) the first sentence of the paragraph/text)
- In one sentence, summarise the content b) (what the paragraph/whole text was about)

# Engage:

- 1. Were any words new to you? (3 maximum)
- Try to work out their meaning from the a) words around them in the sentence.
- Try to break the word/s down into b) syllables/parts and see if these remind you of words you already know.
- c) Use an available resource (e.g. dictionary, glossary, partner, etc.) to find the definition/synonyms/antonym
- 2. Apart from vocabulary, do you have any questions about what you've read?

## Evaluate:

- Which words were the most important and why? (3 maximum)
- 2. Which <u>sentence</u> was the most interesting and why?
- 3. a) Identify the key idea or piece of **information** (What did the writer really want you to know?).
- 3. **b)** Try to **link the text** to something else you know or have read.
- 4. How might this text be useful to you?
