Consequence System

C1

1. First warning given.
2. Second warning given.
3. Behaviour Point (BP) is logged on SIMS and parents notified via email.
4. Students receive a C2 Middle Leaders' Detention (MLD) after 3 BPs.

C2

1. Subject teacher logs consequence on SIMS and phones home the same day.
2. Middle Leaders' Detention takes place the following day until 3.15/4.15pm in the hall.
3. All P.5 and 6 teachers remind students that they have a MLD.

On call: Students must stand outside the classroom until a member of SLT/HOY has arrived.

C3

1. Day in internal isolation (following day).

Report System

TUTOR REPORT:

- 2 week Stage 1 report following discussion between Head of Year (HOY) and tutor.
- 3 targets set.
- Tutor to check targets daily within tutor.

HOY REPORT:

- 2 week Stage 2 report following tutor report and/or serious concerns.
- 3 targets set.
- AHOY/HOY to check targets daily within tutor time. Students must not be sent to get their report card checked, this will happen within tutor base.

SLT REPORT:


- 2 week Stage 3 report following discussion between HOY and SLT link.
- 3 targets set.
- SLT to check targets daily within tutor time. Students must not be sent to get their report card checked, this will happen within tutor base.

1. If a students receives 4 crosses over a two week period, they will be placed in MLD.
2. If a student receives more than 4 crosses, they will receive an SLT detention.
3. Parents will be phoned by the HOY/SLT and the detention will take place at the end of the fortnight.

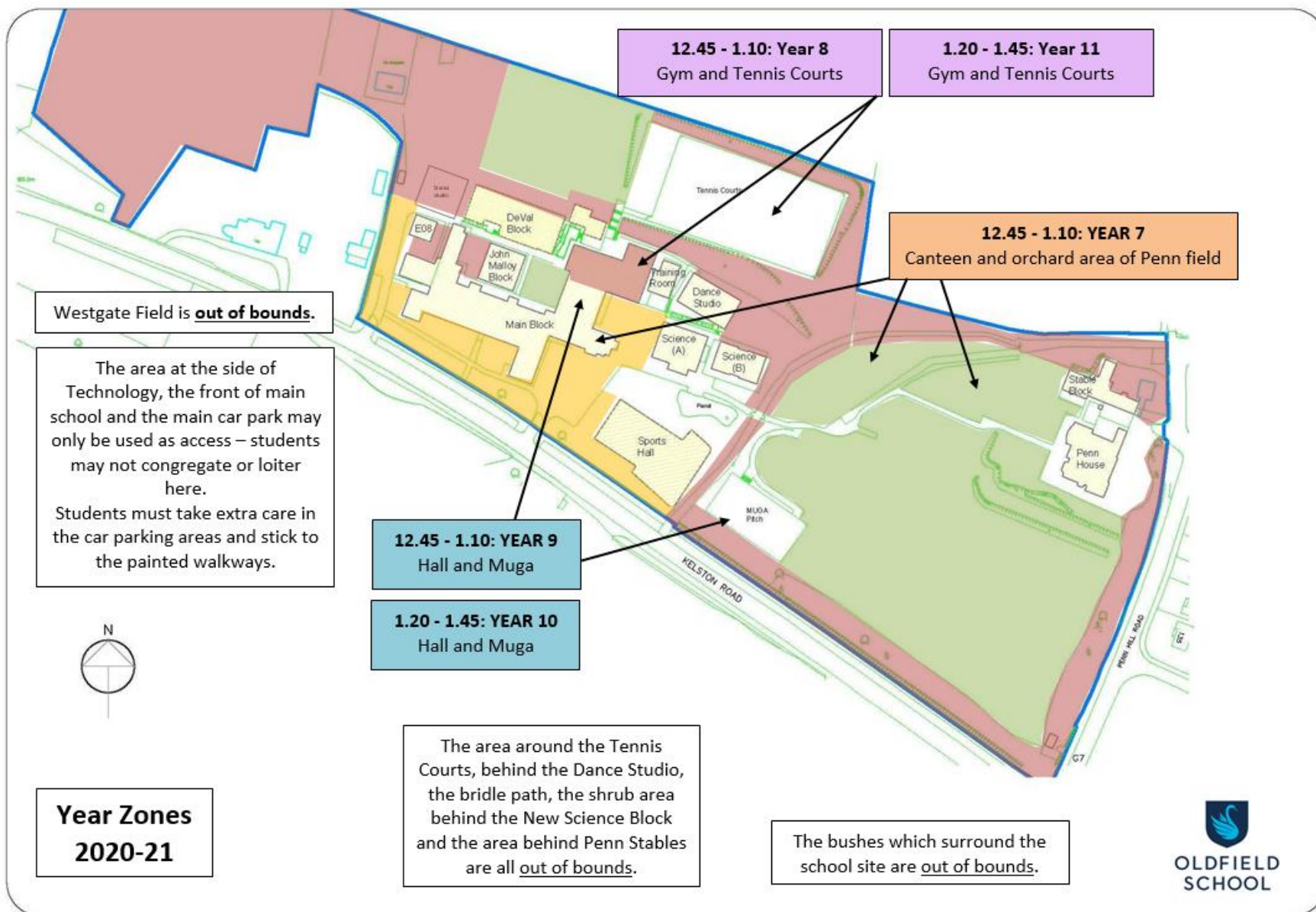
