

Organisation Tips

You'll have to remember lots of things when you start such as books, equipment and homework.

- Plan ahead! Use your timetable to check what books and equipment you need to pack. Pin up your timetable somewhere where you can easily see it.
- Work out your own routine for what you need to do the evening before (e.g. homework, packing bag) so you can be relaxed and punctual in the morning.

Homework


